Easter School – 3 & 4 April 2023

11:00am-12:30pm – Lesson 2

12:30pm-1:00pm – Lunch

1:00pm-2:30pm – Lesson 3

Over the next half term, students will be asked via their tutor to choose their lessons for the day, which includes the majority of subjects on offer for their GCSE curriculum. For the days themselves, the students will need to bring a packed lunch and they are allowed to wear non-school uniform.
